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UNDERSTANDING HOSPICE

What Is Hospice?

Hospice is end-of-life care that focuses on the **patient and their family** — not the illness. It's for those who no longer wish to pursue aggressive treatment and have a prognosis of six months or less.

The focus shifts to comfort and quality of life — **physical, emotional, and spiritual** — wherever you call home.

Care comes to you — a private home, assisted living, or a nursing facility — and continues to support your family through bereavement.

WHO QUALIFIES

A terminal illness with a prognosis of six months or less. Not sure? Call for a no-obligation evaluation — **anyone can make a referral**, including patients and families.
